RESOLUTION NO. 18-49

AUTHORIZING THE USE OF FRESNO COUNTY SUPERINTENDENT OF SCHOOLS CONTRACT, BID #NC-2016-02 FOR VEHICLE LEASE AND FLEET MANAGEMENT SERVICES AWARDED TO ENTERPRISE FLEET MANAGEMENT, INC.

WHEREAS, the Governing Board (the “Board”) of the Vista Unified School District (the “District”) has determined that a true and very real need exists for the acquisition of white fleet vehicles (trucks, vans, passenger cars, etc.) for the support of on-going support of District site and facilities; and

WHEREAS, Fresno County Superintendent of Schools has awarded Bid #NC-2016-02 to Enterprise Fleet Management, Inc. and allows other public agencies to utilize the same terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS, Section 20118 and 20652 of the California Public Contract Code, allows public agencies to utilize RFPs/Bids awarded by other public agencies obtaining the same price and same terms and conditions as the awarding agency when the awarding agency follows their California statutory criteria for competitive bidding; and

WHEREAS, the Board of the District has determined that it is in the best interest of the District to authorize the acquisition of white fleet vehicles over a five year term utilizing the piggybackable contract from Fresno County Superintendent of Schools, NC-2016-02 for Vehicle Lease and Fleet Management (“Piggyback Contract”);

NOW, THEREFORE, the District Board hereby finds, determines, declares and resolves as follows:

Section 1. The Board hereby finds and determines all of the recitals set forth above are true and correct.

Section 2. The Board hereby finds and determines the acquisition of white fleet vehicles under a Piggyback Contract pursuant to Public Contract Code section 20118 to be in the best interest of the District.

Section 3. The Assistant Superintendent-Business Services is hereby authorized and directed to do any and all things and to execute and deliver any and all documents which they may, in consultation with legal counsel, deem necessary or advisable in order to consummate this transaction and otherwise carry out, give effect to and comply with the terms and intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective as of the date of its adoption.
