**RESOLUTION NO. 18-20**

**AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE COOPERATIVE PURCHASING NETWORK (TCPN)**

**WHEREAS**, the Governing Board (the “Board”) of the Vista Unified School District (the “District”) has determined that a true and very real need exists for the acquisition of certain supplies, materials, and equipment. The Cooperative Purchasing Network (TCPN) is an intergovernmental cooperative purchasing agreement between certain government agencies. These agencies have conducted a formal competitive process for the acquisition of various supplies, materials, and equipment such as school and office supplies, etc;

**WHEREAS**, Section 20118 and 20652 of the California Public Contract Code, allow public agencies to utilize RFPs/Bids awarded by other public agencies obtaining the same price and same terms and conditions as the awarding agency when the awarding agencies follows their statutory criteria for competitive bidding; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board of the District has determined that it is in the best interest of the District to authorize acquisition of materials, supplies, and equipment, procured by The Cooperative Purchasing Network (TCPN) (“Piggyback Contract”); and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the District Board hereby finds, determines, declares and resolves as follows:

Section 1. All of the recitals set forth above are true and correct and the Board so finds and determines.


Section 2. The Board hereby finds and determines the acquisition of the (the supplies, materials, and equipment) under a Piggyback Contract pursuant to Public Contracts Code section 20118 and 20652 to be in the best interest of the District.

Section 3. The Assistant Superintendent-Business Services is hereby authorized and directed to do any and all things and to execute and deliver any and all documents which they may, in consultation with legal counsel, deem necessary or advisable in order to consummate this transaction and otherwise carry out, give effect to and comply with the terms and intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective as of the date of its adoption.
