**AUTHORIZING THE USE OF CALIFORNIA MULTIPLE AWARD SCHEDULE
(CMAS) CONTRACT #4-01-56-0006A
CONSTRUCTION ROOFING-MATERIAL**

WHEREAS, the Governing Board (the "Board") of the Vista Unified School District (the "District") has determined that a true and very real need exists for the acquisition of roofing materials.

WHEREAS, Public Contract Code 20118 authorizes public entities to participate in the legal, bid contracts of other school districts, public corporations or state agencies, JPA's, cities and counties

WHEREAS, Section 10290 and 12101.5 of the California Public Contract Code, include approval for local government agencies to use California Multiple Award Schedule (CMAS) for acquisition of information technology and non-information technology products and services; and

WHEREAS, the Board of the District has determined that it is in the best interest of the District to authorize acquisition of roofing materials utilizing CMAS contract #4-01-56-0006A awarded to The Garland Company, Inc. and

NOW, THEREFORE, the District Board hereby finds, determines, declares and resolves as follows:

Section 1. All of the recitals set forth above are true and correct and the Board so finds and determines.

Section 2. The Board hereby finds and determines the acquisition of the roofing materials to be in the best interest of the District to use the California Multiple Award Schedules awarded to The Garland Company, Inc.

Section 3. The Assistant Superintendent-Business Services is hereby authorized and directed to do any and all things and to execute and deliver any and all documents which they may, in consultation with legal counsel, deem necessary or advisable in order to consummate this transaction and otherwise carry out, give effect to and comply with the terms and intent of this Resolution.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be effective as of the date of its adoption.


