Medical concerns

At the beginning of the year all student emergency cards will be reviewed by the school nurse. Teachers will be notified of any students with medical needs such as diabetes, seizure disorder or severe asthma or bee sting allergy and any special accommodations that might be necessary to assist these students. This information is confidential and will be distributed on a need to know basis.

Staff medical concerns

At the beginning of the school year, a form will be distributed to all staff requesting medical information that you may think the health office staff may need to know, if there were an emergency or health problem. Be assured that this information will remain confidential and that this information is not part of your permanent record.

Student referrals

In the event that you have a student you think needs a nurse assessment or health counseling, you can refer them to the nurse by a nursing referral a note in the nurse's mailbox or by e-mail.

Special Education Reports

As a part of the IEP process, a nurse's report is required. As each initial or triennial health report is completed, a copy will be forwarded to the case manager. Every effort will be made to complete these reports in a timely manner.
